

# THE GARRAWI INDIGENOUS SCHOLARSHIP

(supported by the University's Alumni)

## CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. The scholarship shall be known as **The *Garrawi* Scholarship (supported by the University's Alumni)**

[*Garrawi* is the Darug name for the sulphur-crested cockatoo - common at Macquarie University campus at various times of the year]

2. The scholarship is to be offered at Macquarie University from funds donated by the Standing Committee of Convocation on behalf of University Alumni.
3. The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage Indigenous students to enrol or undertake postgraduate university studies at Macquarie University.
4. The scholarship shall be awarded to an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person on the basis of academic merit and demonstrated commitment to Indigenous community advancement.
5. The scholarship shall be available to candidates enrolled in a postgraduate program.
6. The scholarship shall be awarded on the recommendation of a Selection Committee to be determined by the Head of Warawara Department of Indigenous Studies. The Selection Committee shall include a representative of Standing Committee of Convocation.
7. The scholarship shall have the value of \$2,500 payable to the recipient in two equal instalments at the beginning of each semester.
8. The scholarship may be awarded each year and shall be tenable for that year.
9. The Scholarship can be shared equally between two candidates in exceptional circumstances by recommendation of the Selection Committee.
10. The recipient can hold another scholarship or award concurrently with the scholarship.
11. A recipient of this scholarship is eligible to re-apply for this scholarship at a future time.
12. The recipient shall be responsible for fees levied by the University in relation to her/his degree.
13. The recipient may be required, as a condition of the scholarship, to be involved in some alumni activities during the year.
