

An Extract from the Convocation Rules:

- 24 (d) In determining the persons to be recommended under subclause (c) (i), the Nominations Committee is to take into consideration:
- (i) whether a person has developed, or has the capacity to develop:
 - (1) a good understanding of what the alumni community needs from the University, and
 - (2) strong external networks that may benefit the University, and
 - (ii) whether a person will contribute to the effective working of the Standing Committee, and
 - (iii) whether a person has the expertise and experience (identified under subclause (b)) needed to complement that of existing members of the Standing Committee, and
 - (iv) whether a person has an appreciation of the object, values, functions and activities of the University, and
 - (v) such other matters as the Nominations Committee considers appropriate.
